CAMP SESSION DATES, FIELD TRIP AND COST PER WEEK

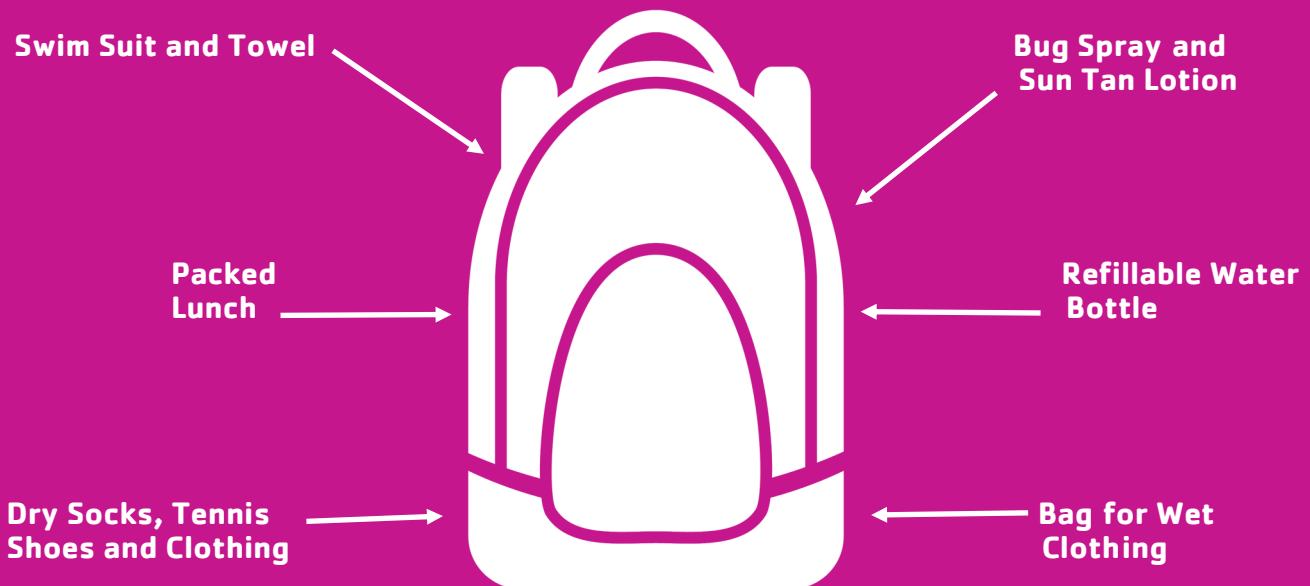
Camp runs daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
